



WOF = Width of fabric LOF = Length of fabric *Sew strips via short ends, then subcut as indicated in pattern

BLOCK ASSEMBLY

Note: The arrows in diagrams represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations while assembling the various components.

- Sew (1) H 1-3/4" x 6" rectangle to opposite sides of (1) D 6" square. Sew (1) H 1-3/4" x 8-1/2" rectangle to the top and bottom to make (1) UNIT 1. Trim to measure 7-1/2" square. Make 10.
- Sew (1) G 1-3/4" x 6" rectangle to opposite sides of (1) D 6" square. Sew (1) G 1-3/4" x 8-1/2" rectangle to the top and bottom to make (1) UNIT 2. Trim to measure 7-1/2" square. Make 10.
- Sew (1) K 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" rectangle to opposite sides of (1) UNIT 1. Sew (1) K 1-1/2" x 9-1/2" rectangle to the top and bottom to make (1) UNIT 3. Make 10.
- Sew (1) J 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" rectangle to opposite sides of (1) UNIT 2. Sew (1) J 1-1/2" x 9-1/2" rectangle to the top and bottom to make (1) UNIT 4. Make 10.
- Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (80) A 3-7/8" squares. Place (1) marked square right sides together on (1) 3-7/8" E square. Stitch 1/4" on both sides of the drawn line, cut on the line and press each unit open. Trim units to measure 3-1/2" square. Make (160) UNIT 5.



- Cut each A and L 4-1/4" square diagonally in half twice to make a total of (80) QSTs. Cut each E 4-1/4" square diagonally in half twice to make (160) QSTs.
- Lay out (2) E and (1) each A and L 4-1/4" QSTs as shown. Sew into pairs and join the pairs to make UNIT 6, measures 3-1/2" square. Make 80.
- Noting orientation, sew a UNIT 5 to opposite sides of (1) UNIT
 6 to make (1) UNIT 7. Make 80.
- Sew UNIT 7 to opposite sides of (1) UNIT 3. Sew B 3-1/2" squares to both ends of (2) UNIT 7. Sew to the top and bottom to make BLOCK 1, measures 15-1/2" square. Make 10.
- Sew UNIT 7 to opposite sides of (1) UNIT 4. Sew F 3-1/2" squares to both ends of (2) UNIT 7. Sew to the top and bottom to make BLOCK 2, measures 15-1/2" square. Make 10.

QUILT ASSEMBLY: Refer to QUILT DIAGRAM for proper placement and rotation.

- 11. Lay out the blocks into (5) rows of (4) blocks as shown:
 - BLOCK 1 BLOCK 2 BLOCK 1 BLOCK 2 BLOCK 1 BLOCK 2 - BLOCK 1 - BLOCK 2 - BLOCK 1 - BLOCK 2 BLOCK 1 - BLOCK 2 - BLOCK 1 - BLOCK 2 - BLOCK 1 BLOCK 2 - BLOCK 1 - BLOCK 2 - BLOCK 1 - BLOCK 2 BLOCK 1 - BLOCK 2 - BLOCK 1 - BLOCK 2 - BLOCK 1
- 12. Sew the blocks into rows and join the rows to complete the block center, measures 60-1/2" x 75-1/2".

BORDER ASSEMBLY: Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure border cutting sizes. Below are our measurements.

Refer to **QUILT DIAGRAM** for proper placement and rotation.

- Sew J 2" x (75-1/2") strips to opposite sides of the quilt center. Sew J 2" x (63-1/2") strips to the top and bottom.
- 14. Sew A $1-1/2'' \times (78-1/2'')$ strips to opposite sides of the quilt center. Sew A $1-1/2'' \times (65-1/2'')$ strips to the top and bottom.
- 15. Center (1) K $8-1/2'' \times (100'')$ strip on (1) side of the quilt and pin in place. Start sewing the strip 1/4'' from the top edge and stop 1/4'' from the bottom. Do not trim excess. Repeat on the opposite side.



- 16. Repeat step 15 on the top and bottom of the quilt, using K $8-1/2'' \times (85'')$ strips.
- 17. To miter each corner, fold the quilt on the diagonal, wrong side together. Starting at the sewn seam, draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric, leaving a 1/4" seam. Repeat on remaining corners to complete the quilt top.


FINISHING:

Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind with **F** fabric.
